

Intensive Mode Teaching Workshops

Intensive mode teaching (IMT)

is part of the 21st Century student experience. IMT engages students in facilitated learning activities or classes intensively over longer than a few hours in a day, and over fewer days than a traditional course.

Participants will be guided through a **step-by-step process on developing intensive mode units using online guidelines on supporting the student experience of capability development in units with IMT.**

Participants will learn to identify threshold capabilities in their units and to support students to develop these.

In the final half hour, participants will review the draft *good practice guidelines* and be invited to submit comments to contribute to development of the guidelines.
